How does it work?

1. Enter via the [Ford Trailseeker website](#).
2. Select your child's distance.
3. Select minor/school entry
4. Select your school
5. First-time entrants need to buy a Pursuit Timing Board
6. Complete your entry

What distance should my child ride?

A child's age is deemed the age they would be on 31 December of that year.

10 km:

Sub-Nippers (7 - 8 years)

**Please note: The 10 km is a fun ride only and no points will be allocated to any school.*

20 km:

Nipper (9 - 10 years)

Sprogs (11 - 12 years)

Sub Junior (13 - 14 years)

40 km:

Youth (15 - 16 years)

Junior (17 - 19 Years)

Seeding Rules

1. The top racing boys and girls will be seeded in the A-batch on merit.
2. Only boys and girls starting in the A-batch will be in contention for Overall podium positions. Children from other batches will receive points and positions based on their riding time.
3. All **positions count towards points for your school**.
4. Parents are not allowed to start in the same batch as their children to ensure fair racing.
